Apartment Setup is a commitment to locate, gather and put in place furnishings, household items and other essentials for newly housed individuals. A group could facilitate this by soliciting donations to provide everything a client may need to function effectively. Typically set up are for a studio or one bedroom apartment.

WELCOME HOME KITS (supplied for clients upon move-in to permanent housing)

27-gallon storage bin with:

- Twin flannel sheet set & pillow
- Fleece throw
- Two bath towels & washcloths
- Bath mat set
- Pack of toothbrushes
- Flashlight

- 4 place settings of flatware
- Shower curtain & hooks
- Two dishtowels
- Potholder & mitt
- Spatula & cooking spoon
- Can opener

2-gallon bucket with:

- Pack of sponges
- Method all-purpose cleaner
- Ajax cleanser
- Dawn detergent
- Clorox bleach foaming spray

RESUPPLY KITS

For clients we are currently serving, we collect donations to resupply items not covered by food stamps.

Resupply kits can include:
