SOIL AMENDMENTS, FERTILIZERS & MULCH

Peat moss	4 bags (2.5-3 cubic feet each)
Potting soil for containers	4 bags
Chicken manure	6 bags
Bonemeal	1 each
Perlite	1 bag
Fish emulsion liquid	1 gallon
Weed-free straw	4 bales
Organic garden soil (one delivery)	5-6 cubic yards
Lime	1 bag
Potting soil for seed starts	3 bags
Mini green house	1 each

TOOLS

Cloth row cover	1 roll
Spade pitchfork (heavy duty)	1
