Migrants and refugees have endured great hardship—sometimes for many years. Meeting their basic needs and providing initial services once they reach the U.S. helps put them on a path to self-sufficiency. We welcome all migrants and refugees as our brothers and sisters.

- ▶ **1,000+** open immigration legal cases, including deportation removal defense, DACA renewals, and applications for asylum from survivors of human trafficking, domestic violence, and sexual assault
- ▶ **10,000+** refugees fleeing persecution and war have been resettled in Oregon by Catholic Charities since the early 1940s

The State of Homelessness

Oregon has one of the highest rates of homelessness in the nation, with more than 14,000 men, women, and children living without the safety of shelter every day. Our innovative housing programs are giving hope, help, and home to more people in need—thanks to you.

- ▶ **817 units** of affordable housing, with another **800 units in our development pipeline**
- ▶ **25 properties** across Oregon
- ▶ **1,900 individuals** and families housed



as we face a new reality, Catholic Charities of Oregon continues to stand in solidarity with the most vulnerable in our community.


Guided by our faith and supported by generous donors like you, we're helping the poor, hungry, and homeless take steps to renewal, self-sufficiency, and empowerment.

Kenton Women's Village

Among our many housing programs is Kenton Women's Village, a temporary safe haven where women experiencing homelessness find a greater sense of security and stability, along with access to permanent housing, healthcare, job training, and more. You help make it all possible.

- ▶ **96% have transitioned** into permanent housing or have pursued other housing options
- ▶ **97% have retained** their housing after one year
- ▶ **100% are connected** with health insurance and a primary care provider



Intercultural Counseling Center

Difficult life events and circumstances can affect our ability to connect with ourselves, our loved ones, and our communities. Catholic Charities' team of skilled clinicians come from a variety of backgrounds and provide culturally competent, compassionate services so people in need can find hope, healing, and wellness.

- ▶ **100% of parenting** and pregnancy support clients are offered access to counseling
- ▶ **100% of counselors** are trained in trauma-informed care
- ▶ **71% of counselors** are people of color

Save First Financial Wellness


In partnership with local businesses, volunteers, and donors like you, our Save First program is helping people living at the margins discover financial independence. Participants learn to create savings, track expenses, reduce debt, and manage credit.

- ▶ **2,504** clients served last year
- ▶ **91%** are actively tracking their budget
- ▶ **62%** have paid down debt
- ▶ **83%** of clients have increased their credit score by 33 points or more

REVENUE AND EXPENSES for the Year Ending June 30, 2019.


